THE CONFESSION OF SIN

When we fail, draw us into a deeper recognition of our utter dependence upon you and constant need of the gospel. Holy Spirit, transform our hearts by renewing our minds. Spread your holiness through every corner of our lives, so that we obey not out of slavish fear but out of joyful reverence for the God who loved us so much. Teach us to see God's law as the perfect guide for our steps, and to revel in the freedom that is ours in Christ, who has taken away the law's threats by nailing them to the cross, making peace between us and God. Have your way within us according to your own good pleasure, as a potter shapes the clay for his own purposes. In Jesus' name, amen.
