Jesus, the Man of Sorrows, humble, weary, bleeding for us but at the same time the glorious Lamb upon the throne, crowned with many crowns and worshiped by angelic hosts, and the Holy Spirit, the Lord and Giver of life who is graciously at work in our hearts and lives. Cause us to know and feel God's great love for us until we are transformed into people who love others deeply because of a great sense of our own need and an undeniable sense of our forgiveness and adoption. Open our lips to join the heavenly worship service and sing praises to our heavenly King today, tomorrow and forevermore. Amen.

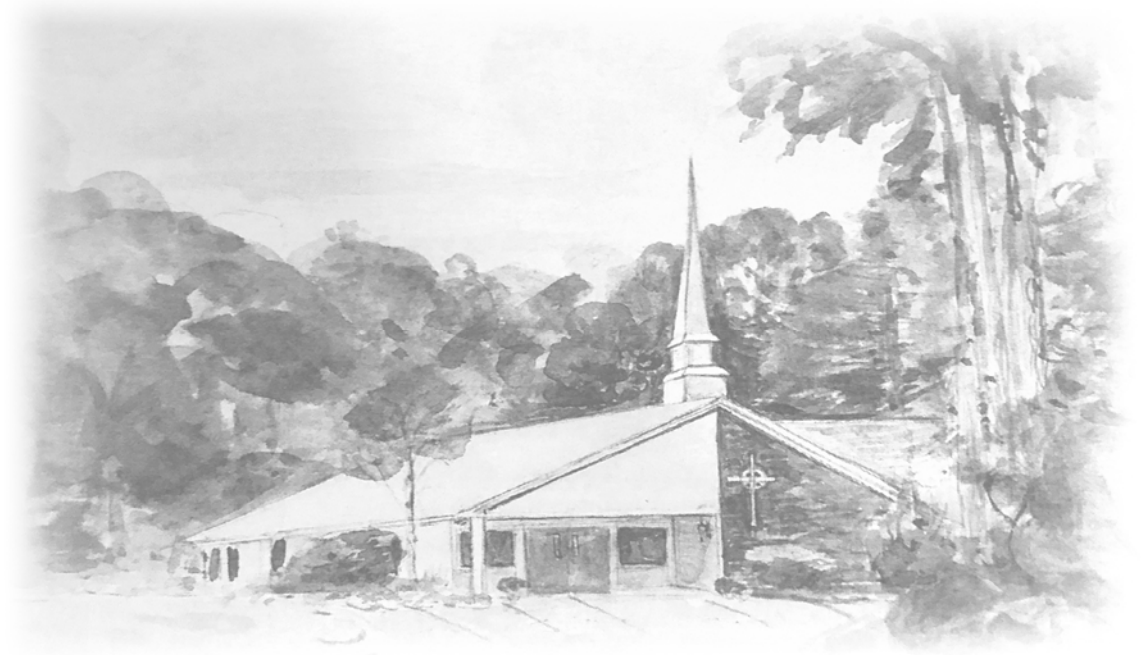
