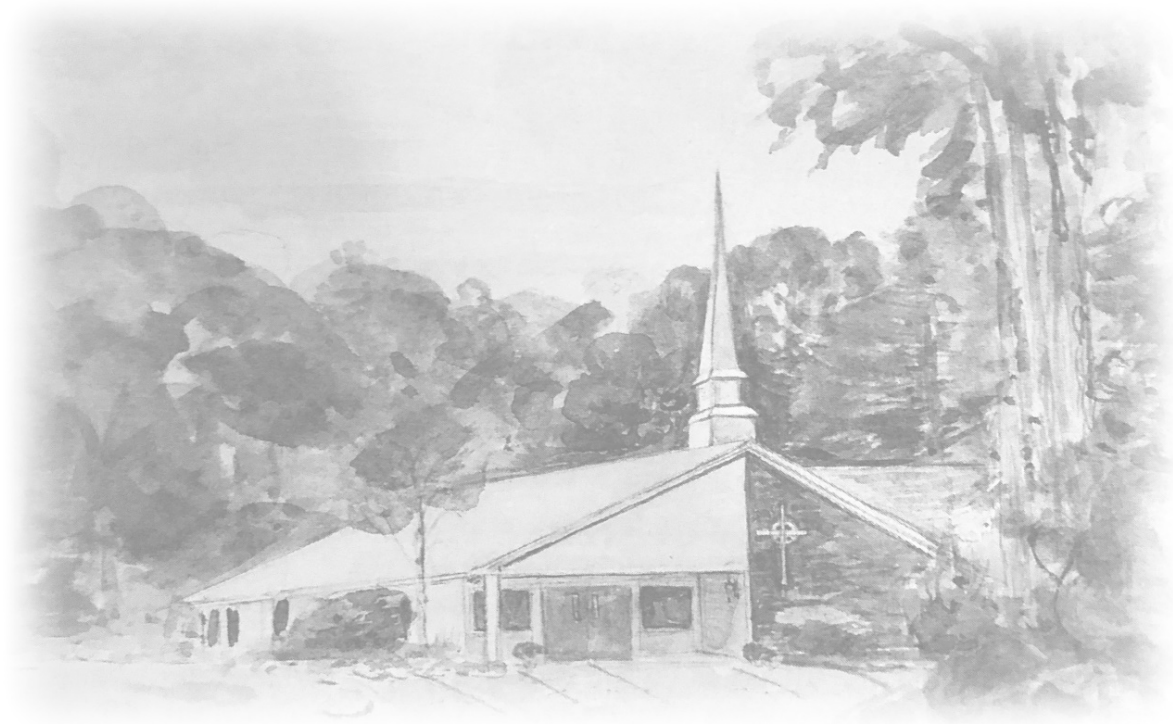

Q. What do we pray for in the fourth petition?

A.
