THE CONFESSION OF OUR SINS TO GOD

Clear our spiritual vision, we pray, that we might see our souls as hidden with Christ on high, our Savior and our God. In his name we come, amen.

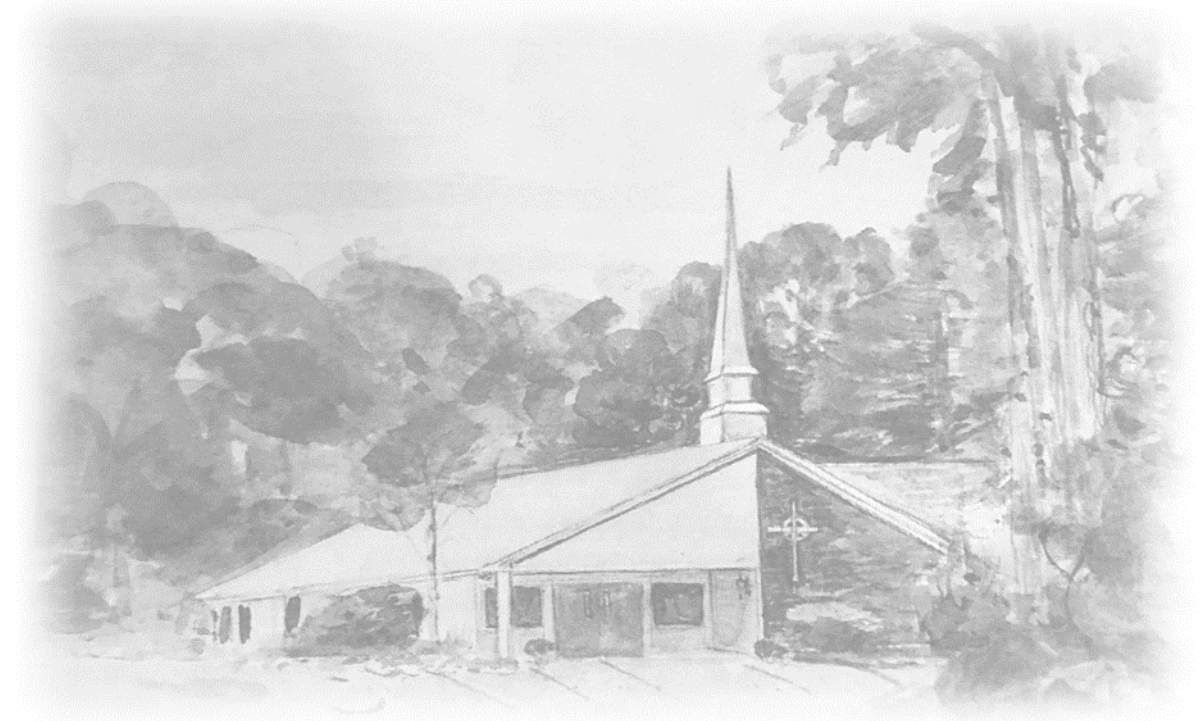
