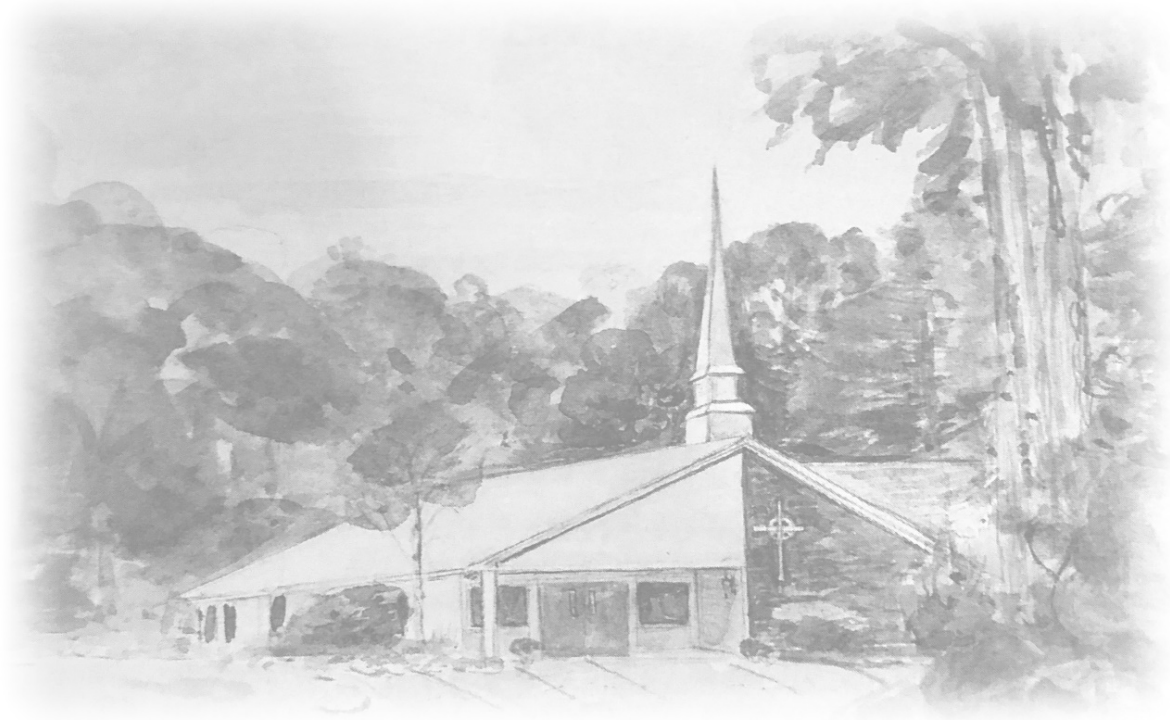

THE CONFESSION OF OUR SINS TO GOD
