Change our hearts to love what you love and to desire your will more than our own. When we long for love and you do not give it as we wish, help us to trust you and run to you believing that you are always for us. When we sin, turn our eyes to Jesus and let us see ourselves covered in the gleaming robes of his righteousness and the dazzling jewels of our bridal headdress. Help us to hate our sin and love our Savior, throwing ourselves into his loving arms when we feel dirty, ashamed and unlovable. Remind us often that though this world is a place of sin and suffering, we are on our way to the greatest wedding of all time. On that day we will see the lover of our souls face to face and will fall at his feet, completely lost in wonder at his love for us while we were yet sinners. Amen.

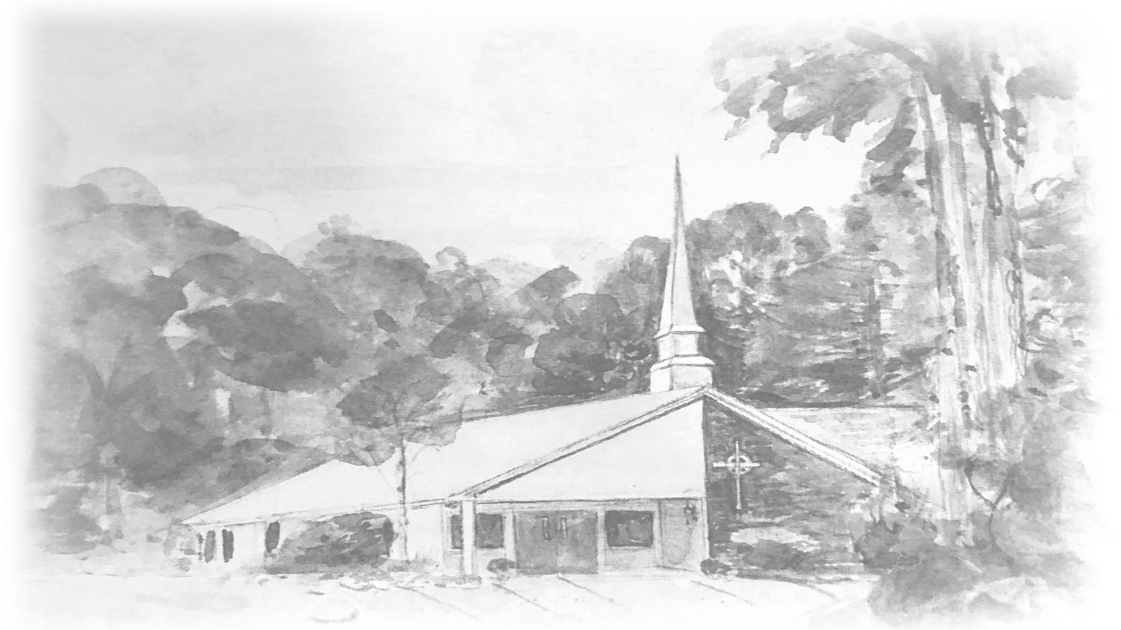
