### **THE CONFESSION OF OUR SINS TO GOD**

Free us to serve others joyfully and to seek their peace instead of seeing them as rivals and enemies. Unite us in our love for Christ and in our desire to stand against Satan's schemes. When we fall help us to forgive one another and to find joy at the foot of the cross together. When we stand tall and strong let us celebrate your goodness and mercy, acknowledging that we remain needy comrades gathered around the cross. Set our minds on you regardless of our own performance and cause us to meditate often on the grace in which we stand firm and on the blood that justifies us. Help us to rejoice in the hope of the glory of God until we see Jesus face to face. Amen.
